

Flexigraze:

High Quality Shearling Lamb from Conservation Grazing

Flexigraze is an innovative social enterprise which achieves several key goals:

- supports North East Hill Farmers
- protects and preserves semi-natural grassland
- enhances biodiversity
- produces ethically reared meat



Flexigraze buys lambs from the North East's hill farmers and uses them as 'natural lawn mowers' in conservation grazing – grazing for the benefit of the flora and fauna that survive on our important grasslands. After a happy life, these shearling lambs are sold as a unique meat, with exceptional flavour.

Our goal is to ensure a fair deal for everyone – the farmer, the lambs and the land on which they graze. Most importantly, the consumer gets a locally produced, premium meat from just £16.25 per pack. Each pack contains a variety of cuts of shearling lamb, including joints, chops and mince.

Set up your own buying group:

It's easy – just get a few friends together! Buying groups work by collectively purchasing half a shearling for just £65. We expertly butcher your meat and supply it to you to split into 4 easy packs. An example of each pack could be.

Leg Shank	½ Shoulder	Leg Fillet	½ Shoulder
4 Chops	4 Chops	4 Chops	3 Chump Chops
			1lb mince (approx)

12 chops are the minimum per half lamb there are sometimes more.
